TWENTYNINE PALMS COMMUNITY CLEANUP DAY SATURDAY, APRIL 9, 2011

The City of Twentynine Palms and Burrtec Waste and Recycling Services will be sponsoring a free drop-off location for Community Cleanup Day on Saturday, April 9, from 8 a.m. until Noon at 74325 Joe Davis Drive, behind the Community Services Building next to Luckie Park, Twentynine Palms.

Household trash (no garbage), scrap metal, electronics, appliances, tires (limit of four rimless tires), and mixed recycling such as paper, glass, plastic, aluminum, and cardboard will be accepted at the cleanup site.

Residents with large loads (trucks with trailers) and green waste can drop off their trash free of charge at the Twentynine Palms Transfer Station at 7501 Pinto Mountain Road between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Seniors or disabled customers of Burrtec who reside within the city limits may request curbside service for large or bulky items by calling (760)365-2015 between now and April 4.

Motor oil, paint, insecticides, and household hazardous waste will not be accepted. Please contact 1-800-OILY-CAT (1-800-645-9228) for proper disposal.

As in the past, the event will feature the Community Cleanup Day Competition. Scout troops, school clubs, athletic teams, and other community organizations are encouraged to participate. Cash awards will be received by all groups and first, second, and third place winners will have their award matched by Burrtec.
